Dear Parents, Guardians and Carers,

I hope this edition of the Governors' Newsletter finds you well and looking forward to an Easter break!

It has been a relatively short term at only 5 week, but school has been busy, as usual.



One of the key things that the Governors have been focused on is the school budget. It is very pleasing to be able to say that the school is in a strong financial position and that our budget for the coming year will leave us very well placed for the years ahead, despite the increased costs that we have all seen with regards to our heating and electricity bills! This positive position is aided a little with the September intake currently standing at 11 students – a welcome return to more typical class numbers. Mrs Stafford-Wood and Mr Room (Governor Finance Chair) have worked hard with Mrs Barker to put in place a budget that has been supported and approved by the Local Authority. The budget plans for all the services delivered by the school; from the teaching, teaching support, dinner and school wrap around to school business administration, teaching supplies and the cleaning! In all of these areas we have a budget that we believe will support the school well as it strives to deliver and support our students to be the best that each of them can be. For example, in this budget there will be a significant investment in IT infrastructure (a WiFi and telephony upgrade), in the IT resources (new laptops) and also in the building infrastructure (toilet facilities refurbishment). We hope to be able to detail additional investments when final discussions have completed.

In most cases, good attendance results in success across a range of outcomes, which are key to a child's overall development.
