### Differentiation:

**Expected** Questions to support recognising that nouns indicating possession end in 's and plural nouns end in s. Using regular and irregular nouns.

**Greater Depth** Questions to support recognising that nouns indicating possession end in 's and plural nouns end in s. Using regular and irregular nouns in a variety of sentence types that contain conjunctions.
