Additional Educational Needs

Here at Youlgrave, All Saints' C of E (VA) Primary School, we believe that parents/carers hold key information and have a critical role to play in their children's education.

Our school is at its most effective when parents/carers are involved; and account is taken of their wishes and perspectives on their child's development.

If we feel your child has additional needs, the school will tell you:

- What we think your child's additional needs are
- o What the school is doing to meet your child's needs
- Whether what the school is doing is working
- How your child feels about what the school is doing to help them
- How you as parents/carers can be involved

Parents/carers can let the school know if you have concerns regarding your child's learning and provision (See SEND Report); and let the school know if your child has seen any health or other professionals outside school regarding any issues: and fulfil your obligations under the home-school agreement.
