In our school we define bullying as:

- A repeated event.
- Where there is an imbalance of power.
- It is an intentional act to a person or a group by another person or group.
- It can be physical, verbal or psychological.
- It can be 'face to face' or from 'behind a screen'.

To help prevent bullying at our school we:

- Be kind to each other.
- Make sure everyone has someone to play with.
- We will ask anyone who looks unhappy if they would like to play with us or leave them be.
- Have play equipment out on the playground to help us get along.
- Everyone should be treated equally.
- We will help younger children solve playground problems.

If we think someone is being bullied; or if we are being bullied ourselves: we must:

- Tell a grown-up we trust in school.
- Tell a grown-up at home and ask them to tell our teacher at school.
- Tell house captains.
- Tell a friend and ask them to come with us to tell an adult.
- Stand up for what we believe in.
