Class 2 have enjoyed taking part in a Sports Festival on the playing fields alongside many other local primary schools. The weather held off (just!).



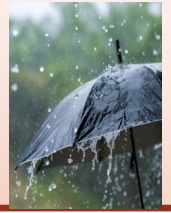

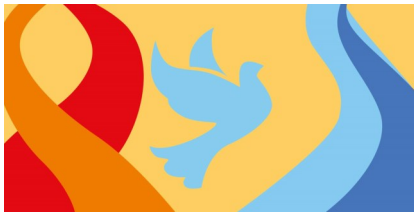
